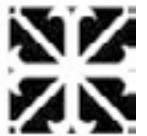

RADIO BROADCAST

We are evaluating our media ministry with regard to our broadcast of our 11am service on CHIN AM 1540. We have been on the radio since the 1940s, and have been proud of that. But there are fewer users of radio—even folks who say they listen to us "on the radio," if asked to clarify, say they are listening through the computer. Being on CHIN costs us more than \$70,000 per year. We do bring in donations to the radio ministry, but not nearly to that level. If we were to go to every single radio listener that doesn't currently have internet access, furnish them with what they need to access the service, and send someone to set up online weekly, TEMC would still save money. So, we want to honour those who don't get out and worship through audio, and also deliver that audio in a way that's taking good care of our resources.

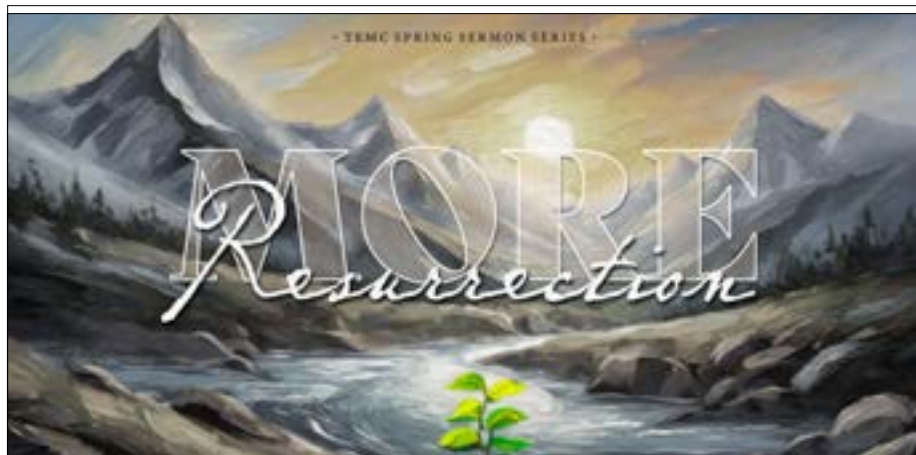

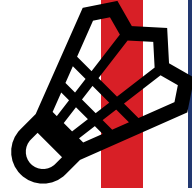
